

**ORDINANCE NUMBER 1.01 (4)(a)**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND RESTATING SECTION 1.01(4)(a) OF THE CODE  
OF ORDINANCES  
OF THE TOWN OF RANDALL, KENOSHA COUNTY, WISCONSIN**

The Town Board of Randall, Kenosha County, Wisconsin does ordain as follows:

**SECTION 1:** Section 1.01(4)(a) of the Code of Ordinances of the Town of Randall, Kenosha County, Wisconsin is amended to read as follows:

“(4) April Election

(a) General Authority

At the annual spring April election in the odd numbered years, the Town shall elect, except as noted herein, the following Town officers, namely:

1. Town Chairperson,
2. Two (2) Town Board Supervisors, elected to odd numbered seats one(1) and three (3),
3. Municipal Judge for a four (4) year term.

At the annual spring April election in the even numbered years, the Town shall elect, except as noted herein, the following Town officers, namely:

1. Two (2) Town Board Supervisors, elected to even numbered seats two (2) and four (4).”

**SECTION 2: EFFECTIVE DATE.** This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and posting or publication as provided by law.

The foregoing was adopted at a regular meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Randall, Kenosha County, Wisconsin, this 25<sup>th</sup> day of MAY, 2011.
