

**ORDINANCE NUMBER 11.07(4) AND (5)**

**AN ORDINANCE RENUMBERING SECTION 11.07(4) AND (5) AND CREATING  
SECTION 11.07(8) OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES  
OF THE TOWN OF RANDALL,  
KENOSHA COUNTY, WISCONSIN**

The Town Board of the Town of Randall, Kenosha County, Wisconsin, does ordain as follows:

**SECTION 1:** Section 11.07(4) and (5) are hereby renumbered to Sections 11.07(5) and (6) respectively. Section 11.07(3) of the Code of Ordinances of the Town of Randall, Kenosha County, Wisconsin is created to read as follows:

“(3) Notwithstanding the foregoing, this Section 11.07 of the Code of Ordinances of the Town of Randall does not prohibit someone from keeping and maintaining goats, geese, chickens, rabbits, turkeys, sheep, or animal of similar size on a temporary basis on a parcel less than two acres in size and zoned in a residential district if such animals are kept and maintained for purposes of exhibition at a state or county fair or as part of a supervised project sponsored by a public school, state or local government or nationally recognized youth organization (such as 4-H Club, Boy Scouts of America, or Girl Scouts of America), provided such animal is kept in a manner and in a location which does not constitute a nuisance and provided further that a presentation shall be made on behalf of the person to the Town Board and such keeping and maintaining of the aforesaid animals shall be only on permission granted by the Town Board after the town board considers the presentation made on behalf of the person and any objections or input from owners of property within 500 feet of the parcel in question.”

**SECTION 2: EFFECTIVE DATE.** This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and posting or publication as provided by law.
